All juniors are encouraged to take the test. Most sophomores should take the PSAT simply to gain test experience and important feedback on areas of strength and areas that need further attention. Only test results from junior year are used in making the National Merit Scholarship decisions. Some reasons for taking the PSAT are to:

- Prepare for the SAT
- Enter the National Merit Scholarship Competition (Juniors)
- Plan for college and careers/ receive information from colleges
- Identify skills for improvement

Testing Time:

2 hours and 45 minutes (plus approximately 45-50 minutes for administrative activities)

- Content:
- Reading Test: 60 minutes, 47 multiple-choice questions
- Writing and Language Test: 35 minutes, 44 multiple-choice questions
- Mathematics: 70 minutes, 47 questions

Registration deadline is Friday, October 6

Fee waivers are available for juniors who meet the federal criteria of low income families.
